Abstract: Giordano Bruno outlines a philosophy of nature that holds together ancient magic and the new cosmological approach. In his philosophy of nature, these elements complement each other, starting from the critique of Aristotelianism. His adherence to Copernican cosmology, pushed to its limits by the theory of the infinite universe, produces a general conception of being and knowledge that reveals the essence of nature in the totality and multiplicity of its dimensions.
