Abstract: With his *Discours philosophiques* (1579), the young Calvinist Pierre de Lostal (1559 ?-1621 ?), presents a summary of metaphysics and ethics, to foster a political goal: he contradicts Bodin. He is famous for the *Soldat français* (1604) that incites, in a very emphatic style, to fight against Spain. The *Discours* share many authorities with the *Essais*, such as Plutarch, Cicero, and Seneca, but the author's Neoplatonism, and baroque emotional aesthetics, move him away from Montaigne.
