Abstract: From the issues of inheritance and self-portrait, as they appear in Montaigne's text, we propose an evaluation of the place of cannibals in the Essays. Next, we revisit the question of the good or bad nature of the natives according to Montaigne, in order to reassess its importance in Oswald de Andrade's anthropophagic speculations. Finally, we make some general comments on gender issues regarding Montaigne's cannibal heritage and the critic of patriarchy by Oswald.
