Abstract: This article aims to specify how Montaigne uses the notion of « good faith » in the *Essays*, examining its connection with the act of recognition understood as admission of ignorance. Stressing its legal origin and meaning, it attempts to show that good faith is not to be understood within the paradigm of fides, in terms of fidelity to given word, but as a piece of the book's gnoseology and ethics of « conférence ».
