Abstract: The three poets Paul Claudel, Edouard Dujardin and Francis Vielé-Griffin met at Mallarmé's "mardis". It is to preserve this memory that Edouard Dujardin created the Société Mallarmé with which Paul Claudel accepted to collaborate initially. But theological and philosophical differences emerged that led him to reply in the negative to Francis Vielé-Griffin, president of the new Academy Mallarmé, who tried to recruit him.
