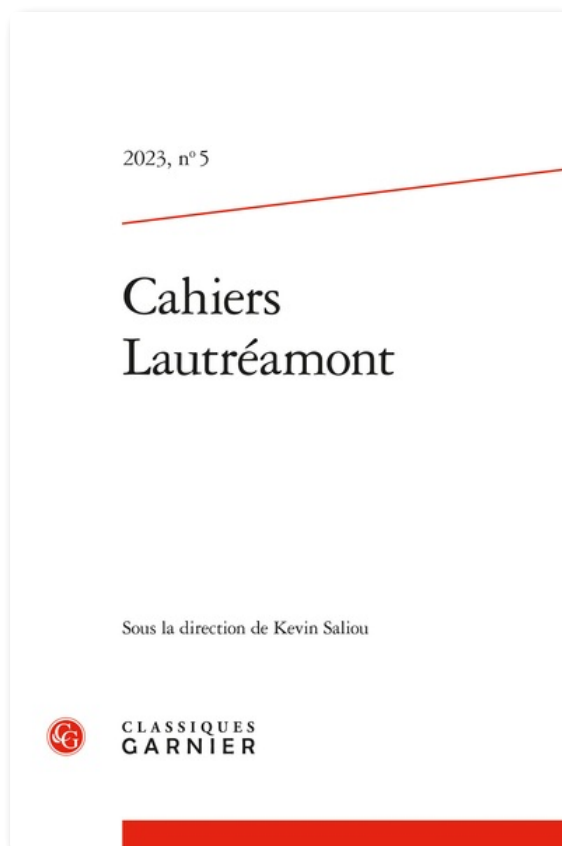

Abstract: After the discovery of Louis d'Hurcourt and Jean Bleumstein, Joseph Durand remains the only unidentified dedicatee of the *Poésies*.
