Abstract: This article addresses the writing I in nineteenth-century travelogues about Finland by British writers Selina Burnby, Robert Edgar Hughes and Edward Rae. The writing I is understood as a persona whom the writer creates while communicating about travelling with the reader. Their travelogues tell us as much about British self-perception in the nineteenth century as they do about the country they visit, Finland.
