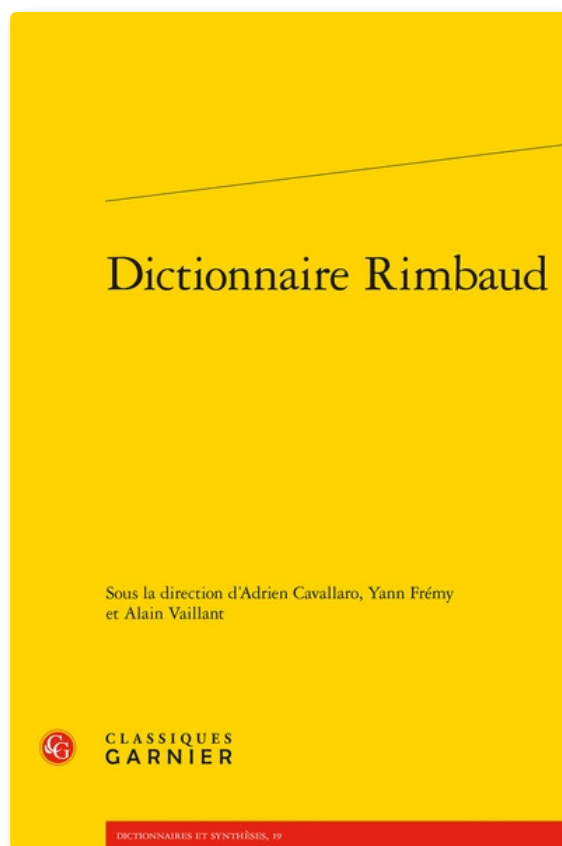




Dictionnaire Rimbaud
