Abstract: This paper focuses on the financing policy of large family firms in Arab countries through a comparative study using panel data between two samples; large listed family firms and large listed non-family firms. The study examines the differences and/or similarities in debt level determinants between family and non-family firms. Broadly, findings show a significant explanatory power of patrimonial variables in determining debt level of large family businesses in Arab countries.
