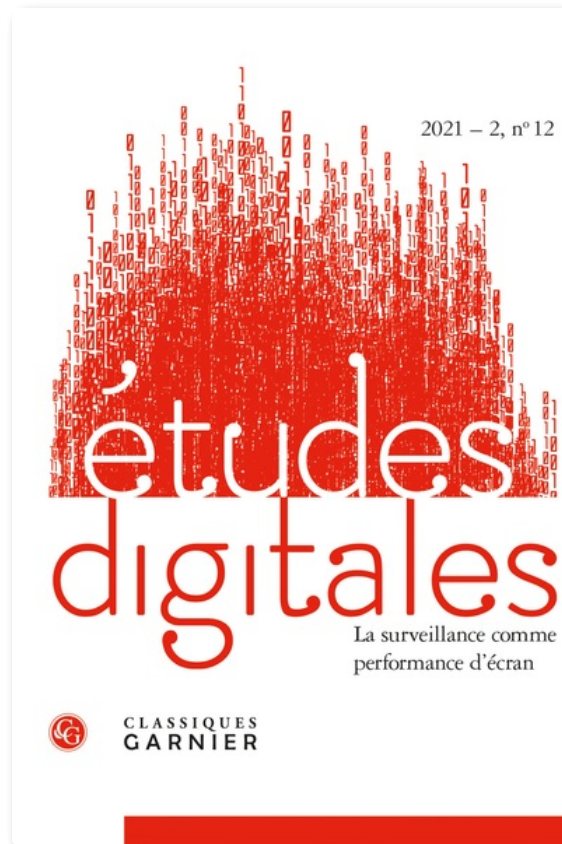




Clinical surveillance on the internet

Abstract: This article explores the transformations of clinical surveillance as carried out by family members in psychiatric settings.
