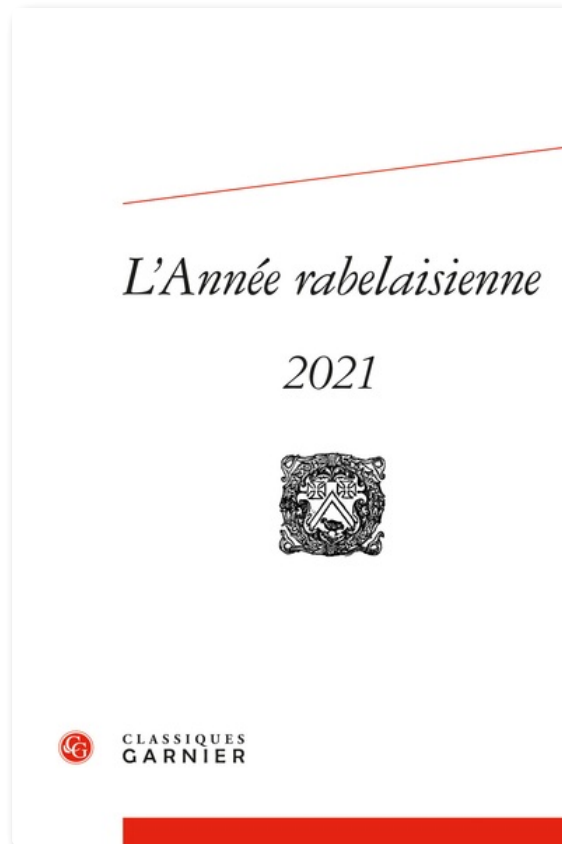




In bonam partem interpretari

Abstract: The biblical expression “in bonam partem interpretari” occurs repeatedly in *Gargantua* and *The Third Book*. Rabelais’s French translations of the phrase exhibit subtle variations, which may say a lot about the change in the relationship between the narrative form and readers, especially in the broader context of “Pantagruelism.”
