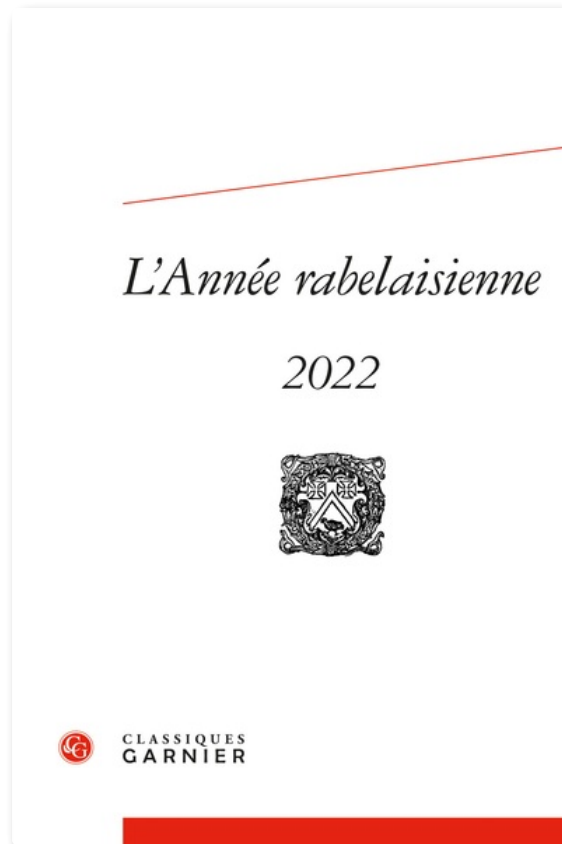




Medicinal plants in the works of Rabelais
