Abstract: In the elegy I, 14 of his collection entitled *Eridanus*, Pontano devises an etiological tale about Virgil's birth. The study aims at demonstrating that, beyond the celebration of the Mantuan poet, the humanist delivers under the veil of myth a fully developed reflection on destiny. The confrontation of elegy I, 14 with his treatise *De fortuna* allows to distinguish this meditation on poetical genius and, more generally, on existence that thus finds an exceptional illustration.
