

Abstract: This article tackles the genealogical roll-chronicles of English kings written in England between 1250 and 1350 and which became very popular during the reigns of Edward I (1272-1307) and Edward II (1307-1327). Mostly written in Anglo-Norman, they incorporate details taken from the *Historia regum Britannie*. Authors of the time had to deal with the difficulties involved in integrating the history of Breton monarchs into their dynastic account; a process that would ultimately reveal an altered perception of the country's history.
