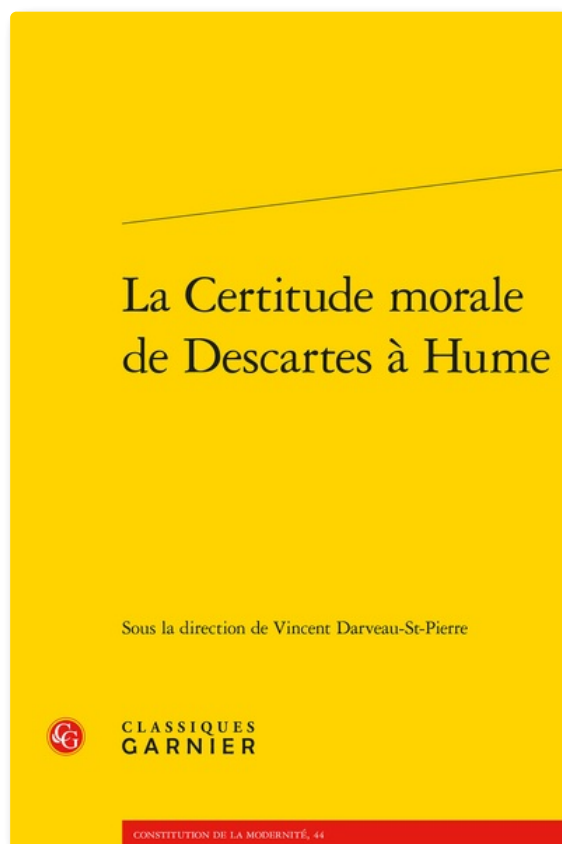




Remarques sur les origines juridiques possibles de la certitude morale chez Descartes
