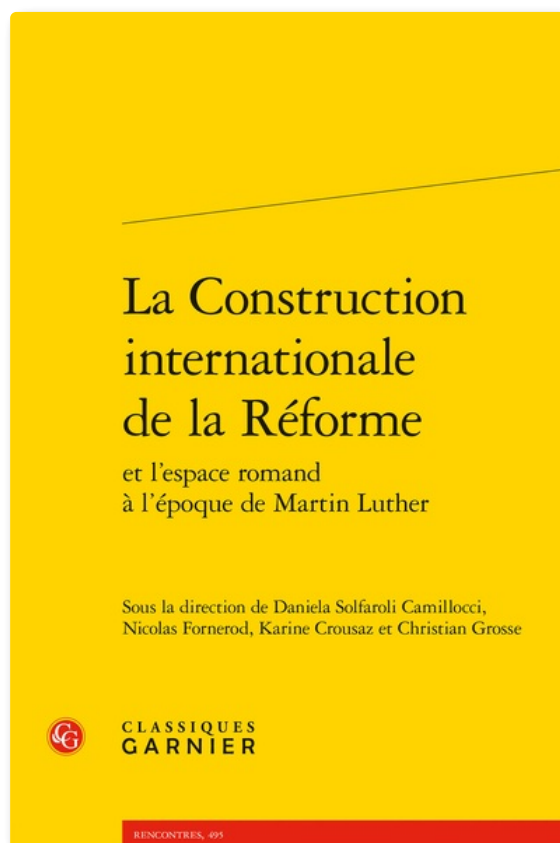

**Abstract:** This paper emphasizes Guillaume Farel's importance in the introduction of reformed doctrine in French-speaking Switzerland. Since 1526 Farel abandoned his Meaux associates, and found new ones in Zwingli, Bucer, Capito and Œcolampadius, These German-speaking Reformers were instrumental in shaping Farel's early publications, particularly the *Summaire* and the *Maniere et Fasson*, which served as the earliest guides to theology and liturgy in the Protestant Francophone churches of Romandie.
