Abstract: From its origins through modern time, the historical event that is the French Revolution has inspired art, as well as rituals, symbols and popular practices the world round. These Revolution-inspired manifestations flourished outside of the official politics of memory, and grew into what can be seen as a subversive way to envision this “myth” that is the Revolution. Far from comparing the construction of a myth to the creation of a critical historiography, this work explores the different geneses of the mythologies that originated with the French Revolution.
