Abstract: German writer who fled Nazism in 1933, stateless refugee in France, Ernst Erich Noth is one of the voices trying to warn the public of the Nazi threat. Friend of Bernanos, he plays the ungrateful role of the prophet. *La Guerre Pourrie* (The Rotten War), is a kind of diary of the years 1938 to 1941, from Munich to his flight from Europe. A lucid witness, he analyzes in particular the ways of the Nazi propaganda in France, but also its limits when it fails to transform Man into a Fanatic.
