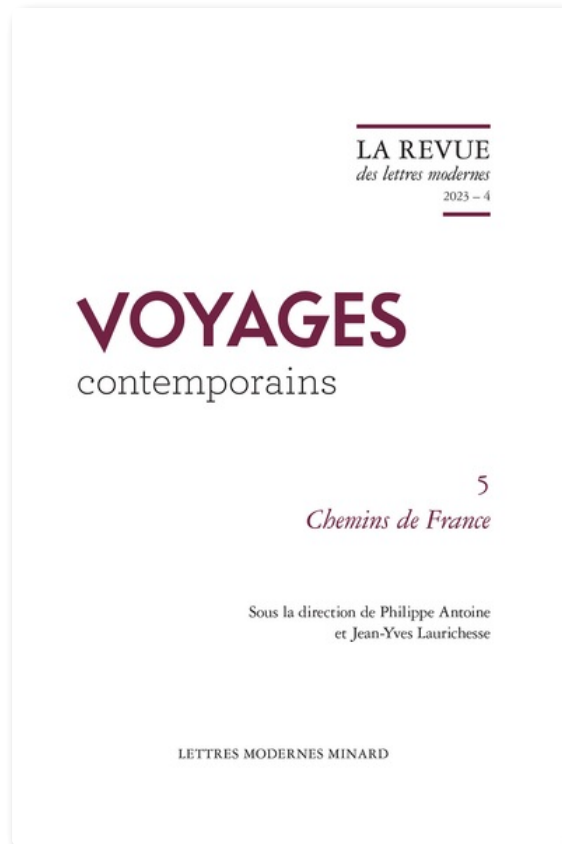




Walk like any other
