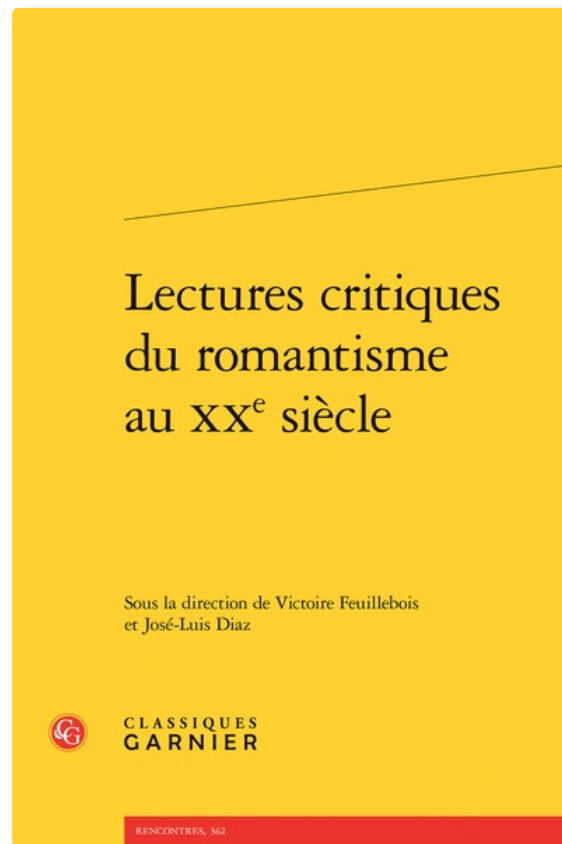




« Échapper à la tutelle du temps »

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Abstract: Ernst Bloch famously characterised the revival of Romanticism in the 20th century as a “revolutionary Romanticism”. It is mostly apparent in the new genre of the essay. It is not a matter of historical affiliation to Friedrich Schlegel’s early Romanticism or of a particular interest in a Romantic, past set of texts, but of a double research, in the works themselves as well as in the form of the essay, for a new articulation of time.

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
