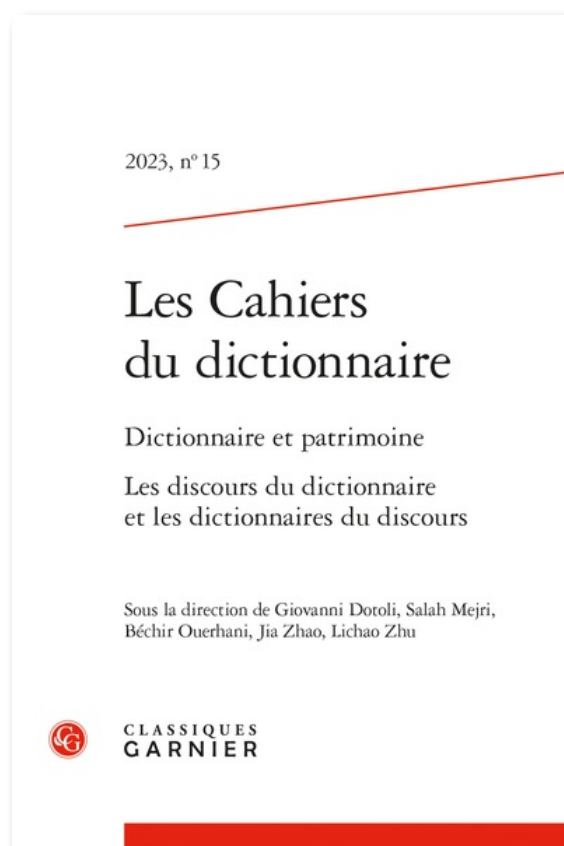




The lexicographic adventure of the lexem “Patrimoine” in French dictionaries

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Abstract: This article is devoted to the diachronic study of the particularities of the lexicographic description of the lexeme *patrimoine* in French dictionaries. Already present in the nomenclature of the first French dictionary of Robert Estienne in 1539 and treated there as a monosemic word, it acquires, over time, meanings of a higher level of abstraction. Thanks to semantic neology, this lexeme acquires new combinatorial possibilities which are listed in modern dictionaries.

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
