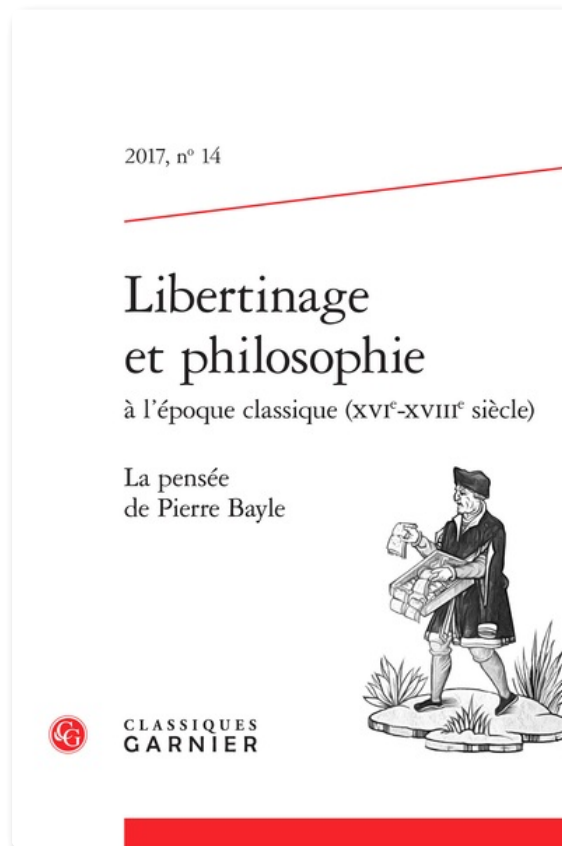




Mandeville a-t-il traduit le *Dictionnaire* de Bayle ?

Une hypothèse à l'épreuve

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Abstract: This article discusses the hypothesis that Bernard Mandeville participated in the first English translation (London, 1710) of Pierre Bayle's *Dictionnaire*. This article first attempts to look at Bayle's influence on Mandeville's production, raises a chronological argument to reject the hypothesis that Mandeville participated in the translation of the *Dictionnaire*, and analyzes this publication in the context of the English book market of the early eighteenth century.

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
