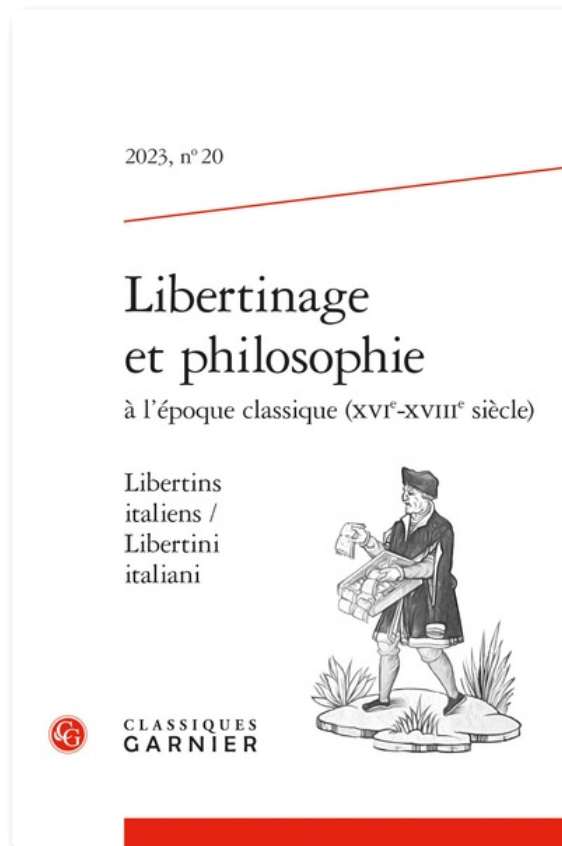




Believing in God, believing in demons

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Abstract: The essay is concerned with the coexistence of libertine and magical themes and sensibilities, with or without explicit references to the diabolical world.
