Abstract: Contact between the Arabian Peninsula and Eastern Africa pre-dates Islam. Today, an African presence is still evident in the Arabic society of the Arabian Peninsula: descendants of slaves and pilgrims, immigrants, traders... It is also evident either as a secondary or, more often, central aspect in the work of numerous authors from states in the peninsula -Sudan, the Emirates, Oman, Yemen- and notably in the work of the Sudanese writer Laylā Al-Ġuhanī and the Yemenite cAlī Al-Muqrī.
