Abstract: The metaphors used by Conti are a tool for the interpretation and modernisation of myths. They are less figures of style than intellectual tools which enable connections to be made between different elements. The chapters of the *Mythologiæ*, deploying all possible significations of the names of ancient Gods, and constructed like a metaphorical field, are the most extreme example of this. Lastly, the use of common metaphors in the *Mythologiæ* reveals the way the world is understood as a divine creation.
