A related publication is a book on Montaigne, *The Order of Montaigne's Essays* (Hestia Press, 1989, ISBN 1-878417-00-2, 247 pages, 19 illustrations, cloth, acid-free paper, volume size 7 by 10 inches, \$16.95). It is a collection of articles that were presented at the *International Montaigne Colloquium* held at the University of Massachusetts at Amherst on October 6-8, 1988. The articles were selected around the central theme of the physical organization of the chapters (essays) in Book Three of the *Essays*. The International Colloquium celebrated the 400th anniversary of the first publication of Book Three in 1588. Reprints of this original 1580 edition (Books I and II) and of the original 1588 (Book III) with notes and all the variants are available through Hestia Press.

The journal MONTAIGNE STUDIES is strongly interdisciplinary and welcomes a variety of approaches from different disciplines and written in either French, Spanish, German, Italian or English. Contributors should follow the M LA style.
