



Les locutions *prendre effet* ou *fin* : figement vs néologisation

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Abstract: The purpose of this paper is to show that the neologization process depends on discourse strategies closely related to social activities in a specific domain (here, the domain of Law). It is centered on French *prendre effet* and *prendre fin*. The authors show how *prendre effet* is not only a set expression but also a neologism, in opposition to *prendre fin*. The analysis is partly based on Guillaume's notion of "subduction".

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
