Abstract: Starting from a state of research devoted to the textual and discursive dimensions of neology, this article underlines the problematic notion of domain and the insufficient attention paid to discursive genres and collective styles. It emphasizes the need to study lexical innovation without restricting the analysis to a single type of discursive norm, but rather taking into account the balance of power at play between all the different norms regulating the neological activity of speakers.
