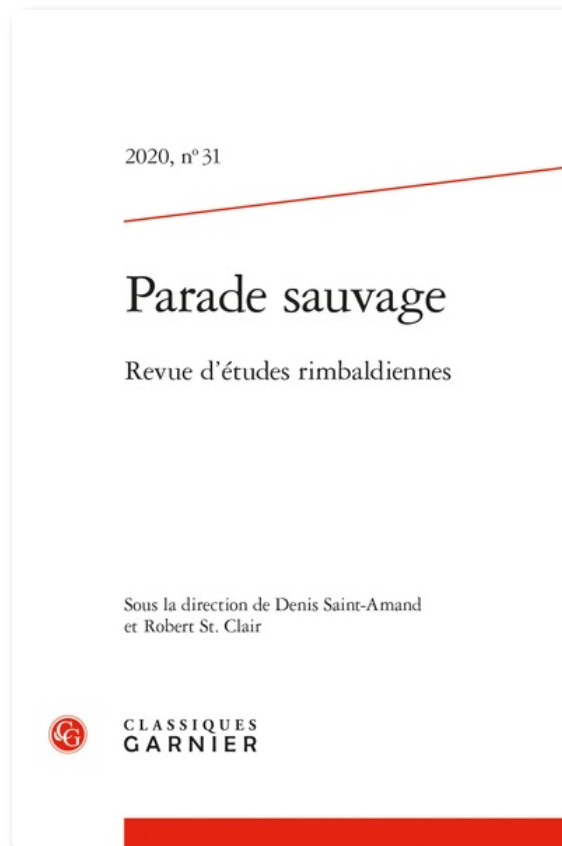




Did Scarron's "Paris" come Before the "Paris" of the *Album zutique*?

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
