Abstract: The assertion of a group of secular small farmers is equivalent to a “Tanguy Prigent moment” (1930s-1950s), but, since the 1960s, there is a rapprochement between the Socialists and the rural world. The partial stall of the Conservative is connected with the reorganisation of the agricultural trade union scene. From the Bernard Lambert generation to the electoral mandates assumed by Bernard Thureau, Socialists reconfigure their networks on these highly decisive issues in Brittany.
