Abstract: In the parts of the *Histoire des variations des Églises protestantes* that he devoted to England, Bossuet adopted a polemical strategy that somewhat differs from the one he adopted throughout the rest of his work. The Anglican bishop Gilbert Burnet had just published the lengthy *History of the Reformation of the Church of England*. Bossuet set out to show, based on Burnet's own text, the impossibility of regarding the Anglican Church as the product of an authentically religious reform.
