Abstract: This article tries to enlighten the epistemological specificity of "Institutionalist Political Economy" (IPE) (Caillé, Boyer, Favereau) by developing, from Paul Ricœur's lecture of Marx, the notion of "institutionalist circle" as a tension between "structural moment" and "hermeneutic moment". This problematic allows us to contribute to a research avenue: in the trail of the dialogue between Conventions and Regulation, that of the construction of a theory of actor in economics which assumes, without reducing it to the opposition between the Subject and the Structure, the intrinsic tension which characterizes the human condition in the social-historic field and which, according to us, really characterizes the "I" of IPE.
