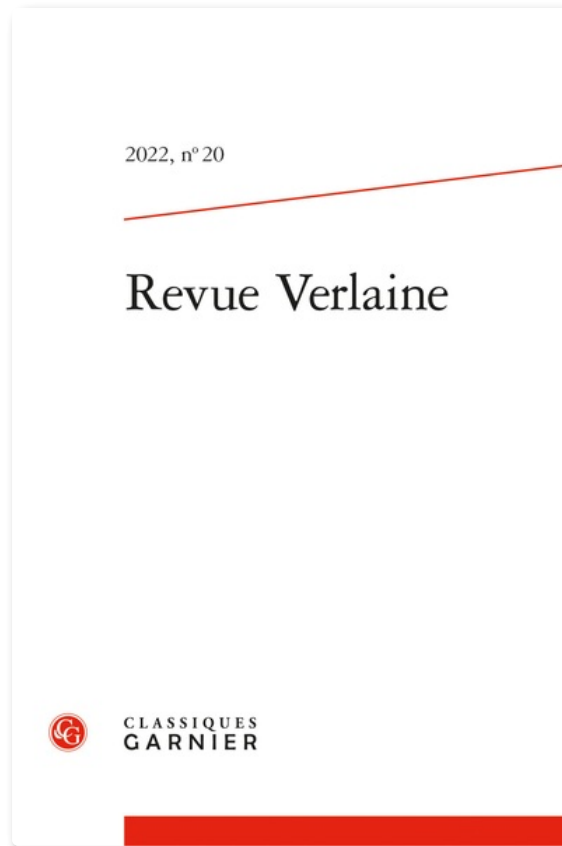




Verlaine and Mallarmé at Oxford
