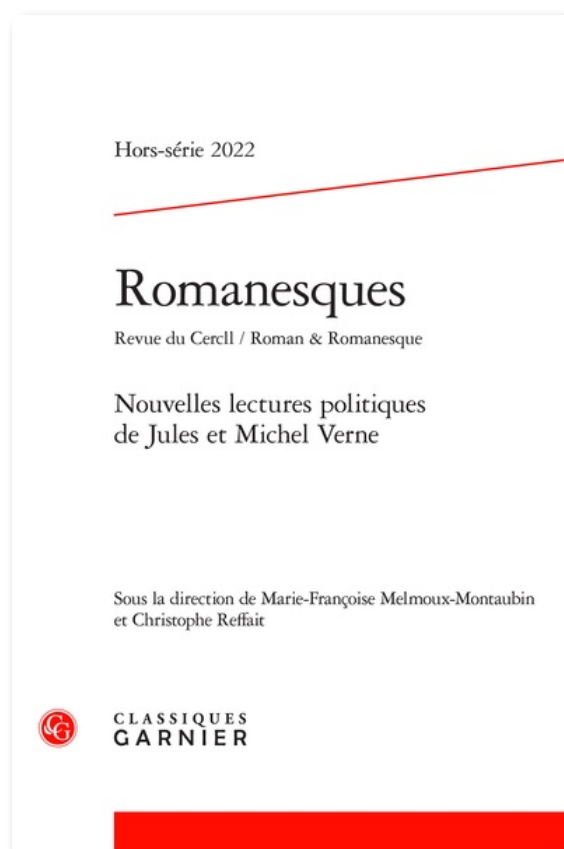




The Television Adaptations of Jules Verne's Novels

The aim is to study this European dimension on the one hand at the level of production and on the other hand at the level of representation.
