Abstract: This article analyzes paths of jobseekers with reduced activity by mobilizing the tools of statistical analysis and a field survey. This paper builds a typology of trajectories of jobseekers experiencing reduced activity. This study uses a panel drawn from databases of the French employment agency and declarations of employers prior to hiring. 8% of jobseekers follow trajectories characterized by an exit to a permanent labor contract, whereas 25% of them are characterized by the use of long term reduced activity.
